## **HOUSE BILL 186**

Short Title: Increase Uniform Juror Fees.

### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE UNIFORM FEES PAID TO JURORS AND TO 3 REQUIRE COUNTIES TO REIMBURSE JURORS FOR ANY PARKING 4 EXPENSES NECESSITATED BY THE JURY SERVICE. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-312 reads as rewritten: 6 7 "§ 7A-312. Uniform fees for jurors; meals. meals; parking. 8 A juror in the General Court of Justice including a petit juror, or a coroner's (a) 9 juror, but excluding a grand juror, shall receive twelve dollars (\$12.00) per day, except 10 that if any person serves as a juror for more than five days in any 24-month period, the 11 juror shall receive thirty dollars (\$30.00) per day for each day of service in excess of 12 five days. A grand juror shall receive twelve dollars (\$12.00) per day. shall receive twelve dollars (\$12.00) for the initial day of service, twenty dollars (\$20.00) per day for 13 14 the second through the fifth days of service, and forty dollars (\$40.00) per day for each day of service in excess of five days. A juror required to remain overnight at the site of 15 16 the trial shall be furnished adequate accommodations and subsistence. If required by the 17 presiding judge to remain in a body during the trial of a case, meals shall be furnished the jurors during the period of sequestration. Jurors from out of the county summoned to 18 sit on a special venire shall receive mileage at the same rate as State employees. 19 20 (b) Each county shall reimburse a juror for any reasonable parking expenses 21 necessitated by the jury service." 22 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005, and applies to jury

23 service that begins on or after that date. (Public)
