A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE KIDS VOTING OF NORTH
2 CAROLINA PROGRAM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Kids Voting of
6 North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of three hundred fifty thousand
7 dollars (\$350,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be used as follows:

8 (1) \$50,000 to be used to implement new Kids Voting programs across the
9 State.

10 (2) \$300,000 to be divided on the basis of the North Carolina Department
11 of Public Instruction's Average Daily Membership with a minimum of
12 \$2,500 for the following counties: Buncombe, Cabarrus, Catawba,
13 Clay, Cumberland, Davie, Durham, Greene, Guilford, Haywood,
14 Henderson, Iredell, Jackson, Lee, Madison, Mecklenburg, New
15 Hanover, Onslow, Randolph, and Wake to assist those counties with
16 their Kids Voting programs.

17 **SECTION 2.** If Kids Voting of North Carolina, Inc., determines that it does
18 not need all of the allocations made by Section 1 of this act, it may use them for
19 expansion of the Kids Voting program in other counties.

20 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
