11 12 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide funding for an Indian Tribal Leaders Summit in North Carolina. The Summit will be held for the purpose of educating and updating tribal leaders regarding key issues affecting tribal sovereignty, Indian education, economic development, and federal recognition of the Indian tribes in this State which do not currently have federal recognition.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
