A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THREE ADDITIONAL
ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS FOR DISTRICT 4.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of two hundred fifty-four thousand eighty-eight dollars (\$254,088) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the three additional assistant district attorneys authorized by this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
