AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THREE ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS FOR DISTRICT 4.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:
