1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE WALLACE REGIONAL WASTEWATER FACILITY, THE RICHLANDS COMMUNITY BUILDING, AND THE WALLACE DEPOT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to support the Wallace Regional Wastewater Facility, which will provide wastewater treatment for the municipalities of Wallace, Teachey, and Greenevers.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Richlands the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to renovate the Richlands Community Building.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Wallace Revitalization Association, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to renovate the historic Wallace Depot, which will be used by the Arts Guild.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
