4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Section 34.13(c) of S.L. 2001-424, as amended by Section
6	38.1 of S.L. 2003-284, Section 9.1 of S.L. 2005-144, and Section 33.1 of S.L. 2005-276,
7	reads as rewritten:
8	"SECTION 34.13.(c) This section becomes effective October 16, 2001, and applies
9	to sales made on or after that date. This section is repealed effective for sales made on
10	or after July 1, 2007. July 1, 2006. This section does not affect the rights or liabilities of
11	the State, a taxpayer, or another person arising under a statute amended or repealed by
12	this section before the effective date of its amendment or repeal; nor does it affect the
13	right to any refund or credit of a tax that accrued under the amended or repealed statute
14	before the effective date of its amendment or repeal."
15	SECTION 2. The lead-in language of Section 39.1 of S.L. 2003-284, as
16	amended by Section 36.1(a) of S.L. 2005-276, reads as rewritten:
17	"SECTION 39.1. Effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2008,
18	January 1, 2007, G.S. 105-134.2(a) reads as rewritten:".
19	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
