A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A NEW DISTRICT COURT
JUDGE IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 3A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

41 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge
 42 for District 3A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the
 43 2008 general election for a four-year term commencing on the first Monday in
 44 December 2008.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172)
3 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the new district court judge for District Court
4 District 3A authorized by this act.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 15, 2006, or the date
6 upon which Section 1 of this act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act,
7 whichever is later.
