**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Community Colleges System Office the sum of fifty thousand one hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$50,178) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Spouse-to-Teacher Program, a lateral entry program for the spouses of military personnel.

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-296 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- "(c2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c1) of this section, an individual participating in the Troops-to-Teachers Program or the Spouse-to-Teacher Program for military personnel and their spouses may be certified as a teacher under the community college lateral entry program regardless of whether the individual:
  - (1) Completed a bachelors degree at least five years before undertaking the program of study,
    - (2) Holds a lateral entry teaching certificate, or
- 19 <u>(3)</u> <u>Is employed as a teacher in a local school administrative unit."</u>
- SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006, and expires July 1, 21 2011.
