A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL
DISTRICT COURT JUDGESHIP IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 6A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

41 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge
 42 for District 6A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the
 43 2008 election for a four-year term commencing on January 1, 2009.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of seventy-eight thousand five hundred forty-eight dollars
3 (\$78,548) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional district court
4 judgeship for District Court District 6A authorized by this act.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective January 15, 2007.
