A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MODIFY THE TIER DESIGNATION TREATMENT OF TAXPAYERS		
LOCATED IN CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL PARKS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 105-129.3(d) reads as rewritten:		
"(d) Exception for Two-County Industrial Park. – For the purpose of this Article, an eligible two-county industrial park has the lower enterprise tier designation of the designations of the two counties in which it is located if it meets all of the following conditions:		
(1)	It is located in two contiguous counties, one of which has enterprise tier designation than the other.	a lower
(2)	At least one-third of the park is located in the county with the tier designation.	he lower
(3)	It is owned by the two counties or a joint agency counties.counties, is under contractual control of designated working on behalf of both counties, or is subject to a devergement between both counties and third-party owners.	<u>agencies</u>
