2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO MANCHESTER CDC, INC., TO  
3 DEVELOP CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN THE  
4 MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP OF CUMBERLAND COUNTY, TO  
5 APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE HOLLYWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY  
6 CLUB IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY, TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO  
7 CUMBERLAND COUNTY FOR THE 71<sup>ST</sup> TOWNSHIP CIVIC IMPROVEMENT  
8 ASSOCIATION, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TIFFANY PINES  
9 COMMUNITY OUTREACH CENTER.

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester  
12 CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the  
13 2006-2007 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester  
14 Township of Cumberland County.

15 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood  
16 Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten  
17 thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for community association  
18 improvements.

19 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Cumberland  
20 County the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be  
21 allocated to the 71<sup>st</sup> Township Civic Improvement Association for civic, cultural, and  
22 senior citizen activities.

23 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines  
24 Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars  
25 (\$5,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to

1 disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of  
2 this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man."

3           **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
