A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND TO SANITARY DISTRICTS THE SET-OFF DEBT  
COLLECTION PROCEDURES CURRENTLY AVAILABLE TO COUNTIES  
AND CITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 105A-2(6) reads as rewritten:

"(6) Local agency. – Any of the following:

- a. A county, to the extent it is not considered a State agency.
- b. A municipality.
- c. A water and sewer authority created under Article 1 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes.
- d. A sanitary district."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2006, and applies to income tax refunds determined on or after that date.
