2 AN ACT TO EXTEND TO SANITARY DISTRICTS THE SET-OFF DEBT
3 COLLECTION PROCEDURES CURRENTLY AVAILABLE TO COUNTIES
4 AND CITIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105A-2(6) reads as rewritten:

7 "(6) Local agency. – Any of the following:

8 a. A county, to the extent it is not considered a State agency.

9 b. A municipality.

10 c. A water and sewer authority created under Article 1 of Chapter
11 162A of the General Statutes.

12 d. A sanitary district."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2006, and applies to
14 income tax refunds determined on or after that date.
