5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105A-2(6) reads as rewritten:
7	"(6) Local agency. – Any of the following:
8	a. A county, to the extent it is not considered a State agency.
9	b. A municipality.
10	c. A water and sewer authority created under Article 1 of Chapter
11	162A of the General Statutes.
12	d. A regional joint agency created by interlocal agreement under
13	Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes between two
14	or more counties, cities, or both.
15	e. A metropolitan sewerage district created under Article 5 of
16	Chapter 162A of the General Statutes.
17	<u>f.</u> A sanitary district created under Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter
18	130A of the General Statutes."
19	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective January 1, 2006, and applies to
20	income tax refunds determined on or after that date.
