1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BLACK UNITED FUND OF NORTH
CAROLINA TO ALLOW THE ORGANIZATION TO SUPPORT ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE AFRICAN-AMERICAN COMMUNITY AND
TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS THAT
SERVE THE AFRICAN-AMERICAN COMMUNITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Black United Fund of North Carolina, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the purpose of helping the organization continue its mission of encouraging economic development within the African-American community and providing grants to community-based organizations that serve the African-American community.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
