1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2005 GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
2 REGULAR SESSION 2006, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT
3 TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO DETAIN INDIVIDUALS
4 THEY REASONABLY BELIEVE TO BE UNDOCUMENTED ALIENS AT THE
5 SCENE OF A CRIME OR A TRAFFIC CRASH AND TO TAKE THEM BEFORE
6 A JUDICIAL OFFICIAL TO DETERMINE IF THEY ARE A RISK TO
7 NATIONAL OR STATE SECURITY, OR TO AWAIT A DETERMINATION OF
8 THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, IMMIGRATION AND
9 NATURALIZATION SERVICE, AS TO THE PERSON'S STATUS.

10 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

11 **SECTION 1.** The 2005 General Assembly, Regular Session 2006, may
12 consider "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT
13 OFFICERS TO DETAIN INDIVIDUALS THEY REASONABLY BELIEVE TO BE
14 UNDOCUMENTED ALIENS AT THE SCENE OF A CRIME OR A TRAFFIC
15 CRASH AND TO TAKE THEM BEFORE A JUDICIAL OFFICIAL TO
16 DETERMINE IF THEY ARE A RISK TO NATIONAL OR STATE SECURITY, OR
17 TO AWAIT A DETERMINATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND
18 SECURITY, IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE, AS TO THE
19 PERSON'S STATUS."

20 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
