A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A LEGISLATIVE STUDY ON RACIAL
BIAS AND THE DEATH PENALTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Services Commission the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to contract with professional researchers to conduct a study on racial bias and the death penalty.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
