AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE UNC-CHARLOTTE CENTER CITY CLASSROOM BUILDING.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of forty-five million eight hundred twenty-seven thousand four hundred dollars (\$45,827,400) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for a new Center City Classroom Building at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte. The new classroom building will house primarily graduate and professional education programs and will aid in the university's effort to keep pace with projected student enrollment.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
