5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-140.4(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) No person shall operate a motorcycle or moped upon a highway or public
7	vehicular area:
8	(1) When the number of persons upon such motorcycle or moped,
9	including the operator, shall exceed the number of persons which it
10	was designed to carry.
11	(2) Unless the operator and all passengers thereon wear safety helmets of a
12	type approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.
13	(3) With a passenger who is under the age of 10 years."
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
