Short Title: TEACCH Program Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Nye; Alexander, B. Allen, Bordsen, Coleman, Crawford, Farmer-Butterfield, Gibson, Lewis, Lucas, Luebke, and Preston. Referred to: Appropriations. February 3, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENABLE THE TEACCH PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITH AUTISM AND OTHER COMMUNICATION HANDICAPS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred nineteen thousand seven hundred forty-seven dollars (\$319,747) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to be used by Division TEACCH Administration and Research at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. These funds shall be allocated as follows: (1) \$132,847 for the Raleigh TEACCH Center. (2) \$149,375 to meet the TEACCH faculty salary mandated increases. (3) \$ 17,525 for administrative staff at the Greensboro TEACCH Center. \$ 20,000 for rent increases in diagnostic clinics. **(4) SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
