## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO TAKE MENHADEN OR ATLANTIC THREAD HERRING WITH A PURSE SEINE NET WITHIN THREE NAUTICAL MILES OF THE SHORELINE OF BRUNSWICK AND NEW HANOVER COUNTIES FROM MAY 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to take menhaden or Atlantic thread herring by the use of a purse seine from May 1 through October 31 of each year within three nautical miles of the Atlantic Ocean shoreline in that area east of a line beginning at a point onshore at the border between North Carolina and South Carolina at  $33^{\circ}$  51.0667'N  $- 78^{\circ}$  32.5833'W; running southeasterly three nautical miles to a point offshore at  $33^{\circ}$  48.8342'N  $- 78^{\circ}$  29.8494'W; and south and west of a line beginning at a point onshore at the border between Pender County and New Hanover County at  $34^{\circ}$  17.6479'N  $- 77^{\circ}$  42.8356'W; then running southeasterly three nautical miles to a point offshore at  $34^{\circ}$  15.6547'N  $- 77^{\circ}$  40.0220'W.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective May 1, 2005, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
