A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR
NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE
TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS AT THE HISTORICALLY BLACK
COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES THAT DO NOT HAVE ANY TEACHING
FELLOWS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred seventy
thousand dollars (\$370,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred
seventy thousand dollars (\$370,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide funds for
need-based scholarships for students enrolled in the teacher education programs at the
Historically Black Colleges and Universities that do not have any Teaching Fellows.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
