2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
3 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR
4 NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE
5 TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS AT THE HISTORICALLY BLACK
6 COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES THAT DO NOT HAVE ANY TEACHING
7 FELLOWS.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
10 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred seventy
11 thousand dollars (\$370,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred
12 seventy thousand dollars (\$370,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide funds for
13 need-based scholarships for students enrolled in the teacher education programs at the
14 Historically Black Colleges and Universities that do not have any Teaching Fellows.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
