& \text { A BILL TO BE ENTITLED } \\
& \text { AN ACT TO PHASE OUT THE COUNTY SHARE OF THE NONFEDERAL SHARE } \\
& \text { OF MEDICAID COSTS OVER A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD. } \\
& \text { The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: } \\
& \text { SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the } \\
& \text { county portion of the nonfederal share of the State Medical Assistance Program is } \\
& \text { reduced by three percent (3\%) each fiscal year, beginning July 1, 2006, until the county } \\
& \text { portion of the nonfederal share, excluding administrative costs, equals zero percent } \\
& \text { (0\%). Effective July 1, 2011, one hundred percent (100\%) of the nonfederal share of the } \\
& \text { Medical Assistance Program, excluding administrative costs, shall be borne by the } \\
& \text { State. } \\
& \text { SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2011, G.S. 108A- } 54 \text { reads as rewritten: } \\
& \text { "§ 108A-54. Authorization of Medical Assistance Program. } \\
& \text { The Department is authorized and empowered to establish a Medical Assistance } \\
& \text { Program from federal, State and county federal and State appropriations and to adopt } \\
& \text { rules and regulations under which payments are to be made in accordance with the } \\
& \text { provisions of this Part. The nonfederal share may be divided between the-State and the } \\
& \text { coumties, in a manner consistent with the provisions of the federal Social Security Act, } \\
& \text { except that the share required from the counties may not exceed the share required from } \\
& \text { the state. If a portion of the nonfederal share is required from the counties, the boards of } \\
& \text { eounty commissioners of the several coumties shall levy, impose and collect the taxes } \\
& \text { required for the special perpose of medical assistance as provided in this Part, in an } \\
& \text { amoumt sufficient to cover each county's share of such assistance." }
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SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
