SENATE BILL 1137

Short Title: Sport Shooting Range Protection.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A SPORT SHOOTING RANGE THAT RELOCATES
DUE TO CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES IS STILL CONSIDERED TO BE
CONTINUOUSLY IN EXISTENCE SINCE BEGINNING OPERATION AND
NOT TO HAVE UNDERGONE A SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE IN USE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-409.46 is amended by adding a new subsection to
read:

"(f) For the purposes of this Article, a sport shooting range that relocates due to
condemnation, rezoning, annexation, road construction, or development:

(1) Is still considered to be continuously in existence since beginning
operation at its previous location; and

(2) Is not considered to have undergone a substantial change in use as the
result of the location."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
