A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ALLOW THE TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY ADVISORY COUNCIL TO STUDY THE NEEDS OF INDIVIDUALS WITH BRAIN INJURIES AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR A STATEWIDE SERVICE DELIVERY SYSTEM.

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Council to study the needs of individuals with traumatic brain injuries and their families and make recommendations for an appropriate service delivery system.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
