A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A STATEWIDE PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN TO REDUCE THE OCCURRENCE OF BOTH SIDS AND INFANT SUFFOCATION AND STRANGULATION.

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to develop and implement a statewide public awareness campaign to reduce the occurrence of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome and infant suffocation and strangulation.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
