A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR INTERPRETER SERVICES IN LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to hire additional qualified interpreters based in local health departments in the State. In addition, these funds may be used by local health departments to provide incentives to recruit and hire bilingual providers. The Department shall allocate these funds to local health departments based on funding criteria as recommended by the State Health Director in conjunction with the North Carolina Association of Local Health Directors and the Department of Health and Human Services Hispanic Health Task Force.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
