5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 10B-8 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 10B-8. Course of study and examination.
8	(a) Every applicant for an initial notary commission shall, within the three
9	months preceding application, take a course of classroom instruction of not less than six
10	hours approved by the Secretary and take a written examination approved by the
11	Secretary. An applicant must answer at least eighty percent (80%) of the questions
12	correctly in order to pass the exam. This subsection shall not apply to a licensed
13	member of the North Carolina State Bar.
14	(b) Every applicant for recommissioning shall pass a written examination
15	approved by and administered by or under the direction of the Secretary, unless the
16	person is a licensed member of the North Carolina State Bar.
17	(c) The content of the course of instruction and the written examinations shall be
18	notarial laws, procedures, and ethics.
19	(d) The Secretary may charge such fees as are reasonably necessary to pay the
20	cost associated with developing and administering examinations permitted by this
21	Chapter and for conducting the training of notaries and notary instructors."
22	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 10B-11 reads as rewritten:
23	"§ 10B-11. Recommissioning.
24	(a) A commissioned notary may apply for recommissioning no earlier than 10
25	weeks prior to the expiration date of the notary's commission.
26	(b) A notary whose commission has not expired must comply with the following
27	requirements to be recommissioned:

(3)Pass the written examination required under G.S. 10B-8, unless the notary is a licensed member of the North Carolina State Bar.

4 An individual may apply for recommissioning within one year after the 5 (c) 6 expiration of the individual's commission. The individual must comply with the requirement of subsection (b) of this section. The individual must also fulfill the 7 educational requirement under G.S. 10B-8(a), unless the Secretary waives that 8 requirement." 9
