"§ 10B-11. Recommissioning. 23

A commissioned notary may apply for recommissioning no earlier than 10 24 (a) weeks prior to the expiration date of the notary's commission. 25

A notary whose commission has not expired must comply with the following 26 (b) requirements to be recommissioned: 27

- Submit a new application under G.S. 10B-6. (1)
- Meet the requirements of G.S. 10B-5(b). (2)

1	(3) Pass the written examination required under G.S. 10B-8, unless the
2	notary is a licensed member of the North Carolina State Bar.
3	(c) An individual may apply for recommissioning within one year after the
4	expiration of the individual's commission. The individual must comply with the
5	requirement of subsection (b) of this section. The individual must also fulfill the
6	educational requirement under G.S. 10B-8(a), unless the Secretary waives that
7	requirement."
8	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
