A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NEW HANOVER REGIONAL 3 MEDICAL CENTER TO SUPPORT THE TRANSFER OF MENTAL HEALTH 4 SERVICES AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL SPACE TO 5 ACCOMMODATE CRISIS SERVICES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to New Hanover 7 Regional Medical Center the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 8 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to support the transfer of crisis services from the 9 Southeast Area Mental Health program to The Oaks Hospital of the New Hanover 10 11 Regional Medical Center. These funds may also be used to assist in the construction of additional space to accommodate crisis services. 12 13

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
