A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE JAMES B. HUNT, JR.  
INSTITUTE FOR EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP AND POLICY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand  
dollars (\$500,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the James B. Hunt, Jr.  
Institute for Educational Leadership and Policy to be used to sponsor a number of new  
initiatives, to improve science and math instruction, to encourage out of school time  
programs for youngsters, and to expand the Institute's reach to vested interests in  
educational improvement such as mayors and chambers of commerce.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
