A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR STAFFING NEEDS AT THE HISTORIC
HOPE PLANTATION SITE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Historic Hope Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to hire a Coordinator of Education and Program Development and Assistant Director for the Foundation, and continue the employment of the current Museum Curator. Additional staff will help facilitate programs that tell the history and diverse heritage of agrarian northeastern North Carolina through the five historic structures and the modern Roanoke-Chowan Heritage Center at the Historic Hope Plantation site.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
