| 8 | SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the |
| 9 | Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Forest Resources, the |
| 10 | sum of three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal |
| 11 | year for a new forestry office and storage building in Buncombe County. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Division of |
| 13 | Forest Resources may retain the proceeds from the sale of the existing forestry office |
| 14 | and appurtenant land in Buncombe County. The Division of Forest Resources may use |
| 15 | the proceeds from the sale to offset the cost of constructing or otherwise acquiring a |
| 16 | new forestry office and storage building in Buncombe County. Proceeds from the sale |
| 17 | not used for that purpose within two fiscal years of the sale shall revert to the General |
| 18 | Fund. |
| 19 | SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006. |
