| 8 | seventy-eight dollars (\$50,178) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Spouse-to-Teacher |
| 9 | Program, a lateral entry program for the spouses of military personnel. |
| 10 | SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-296 is amended by adding a new subsection to |
| 11 | read: |
| 12 | "(c2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c1) of this section, an |
| 13 | individual participating in the Troops-to-Teachers Program or the Spouse-to-Teacher |
| 14 | Program for military personnel and their spouses may be certified as a teacher under the |
| 15 | community college lateral entry program regardless of whether the individual: |
| 16 | (1) Completed a bachelors degree at least five years before undertaking |
| 17 | the program of study, |
| 18 | (2) Holds a lateral entry teaching certificate, or |
| 19 | (3) Is employed as a teacher in a local school administrative unit." |
| 20 | SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006, and expires July 1, |
