

1 dollars (\$500,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to fund the Distance Education
2 Professional Development for Mathematics and Science Education.

3 **SECTION 6.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
4 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million one hundred
5 thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to increase support for
6 student teaching field-based experience. These funds provide matching funds for 15
7 FTE positions to increase the number of faculty providing field-based courses and
8 supervision.

9 **SECTION 7.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
10 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million one hundred
11 fifty-six thousand three hundred eighty two dollars (\$2,156,382) for the 2006-2007
12 fiscal year to fund new teacher support and mentoring aimed at retention. A total of 29
13 nontenure track clinical faculty positions would be distributed to the 15 teacher
14 education programs based upon the number of new teachers produced annually and an
15 approved plan for implementing the statewide new teacher induction model.

16 **SECTION 8.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
17 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand
18 dollars (\$750,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide matching funds for the
19 University-School Teacher Education Partnerships. Through these partnerships,
20 university faculty and public school cooperating teachers and mentors are given
21 opportunities to work collaboratively, broaden interest and depth of knowledge, and
22 affirm professionalism.

23 **SECTION 9.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
24 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand
25 dollars (\$500,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Lateral Entry Teacher Initiative
26 at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte. Funding shall be directed toward
27 preparing more qualified teachers in high need fields for North Carolina's classrooms.

28 **SECTION 10.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
29 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million three hundred
30 twenty-one thousand dollars (\$1,321,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Pilot
31 New Teacher Induction Model at East Carolina University and the sum of five hundred
32 thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the Pilot New Teacher Induction Model at Western
33 Carolina University.

34 **SECTION 11.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
35 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million two hundred
36 fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Summer
37 Ventures in Science and Mathematics.

38 **SECTION 12.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
39 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars
40 (\$2,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the DESTINY Lab at the University of
41 North Carolina at Chapel Hill. This funding would support collaboration with additional
42 partners statewide to develop more learning experiences and teacher development
43 programs.

1 **SECTION 13.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
2 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars
3 (\$2,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for Science, Technology, Engineering and
4 Mathematics Education at North Carolina State University.

5 **SECTION 14.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
6 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million one hundred
7 thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for a Pilot Initiative to
8 Recruit, Prepare, Mentor, and Differentially Reward Select Mathematics Teachers in
9 High Need Schools.

10 **SECTION 15.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
11 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six hundred seventy
12 thousand dollars (\$670,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Mathematics and
13 Science Education Network.

14 **SECTION 16.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
15 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred fifty thousand
16 dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Principals' Executive Program
17 to improve the management and leadership skills of principals in high need schools.

18 **SECTION 17.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
19 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million four hundred
20 fifty-five thousand dollars (\$1,455,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for Expanding
21 Summer School. This funding would support summer school programs at Fayetteville
22 State University and the University of North Carolina at Wilmington.

23 **SECTION 18.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
