AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGESHIP AND SEVEN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY POSITIONS IN DISTRICT 14.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133 reads as rewritten:

"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for District 14 authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2008 election for a four-year term commencing on January 1, 2009.

SECTION 3. G.S.7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of seventy-eight thousand five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$78,548) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional district court judgeship for District Court District 14 authorized by this act.

 SECTION 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of two hundred fifty-four thousand eighty-eight dollars (\$254,088) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the three additional assistant district attorney positions for Prosecutorial District 14 authorized by this act.

SECTION 6. Section 1 of this act becomes effective January 15, 2007. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
