A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN JUDICATURE
2 SOCIETY INSTITUTE OF FORENSIC SCIENCE AND PUBLIC POLICY.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to The American
5 Judicature Society to Promote the Effective Administration of Justice, a nonprofit
6 corporation, the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the
7 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the American Judicature Society Institute of
8 Forensic Science and Public Policy located in the City of Greensboro. These funds may
9 be used for administrative costs in designing, developing, organizing, monitoring, and
10 maintaining a widespread internship program for students in North Carolina and for
11 producing educational programs in the State for members of the general public,
12 students, law enforcement, practitioners, and judges on matters pertaining to forensic
13 science and public policy.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
