A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF

ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES FOR A HABITAT STUDY OF

RIVERS IN THE ALBEMARLE REGION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the Division of Marine Fisheries for a detailed habitat study of rivers located in the Albemarle region to determine the cause of and possible remedies for the decline in the river herring stock.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
