A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RENOVATE AND RESTORE THE
HISTORIC THEATER IN UPTOWN GREENVILLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Greenville the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to renovate and restore the historic 1914 movie theater located in uptown Greenville for use as a performance theater and space for workshops, seminars, concerts, and cultural events.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
