<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of
Greenville the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007
fiscal year to renovate and restore the historic 1914 movie theater located in uptown
Greenville for use as a performance theater and space for workshops, seminars,
