May 26, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ASSIGNMENTS TO THE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE IN-HOME PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services for the 2006-2007 fiscal year may be used to increase the maximum number of assignments to the special assistance in-home program to 1,500 persons. **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
