6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
8 new section to read:

9 "§ 15A-506. Notification of United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.

10 <u>A law enforcement officer who arrests a person for a motor vehicle law offense or a</u>

11 <u>criminal offense, and has reasonable suspicion that the person arrested is an</u> 12 undocumented alien, shall notify the United States Immigration and Naturalization

13 Service, as soon as practicable, but not later than 24 hours, by telephone or letter."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
