A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE BRODY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE
AT EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY TO ASSIST WITH THE COSTS
INVOLVED IN THE EARLY DETECTION OF LUNG CANCER USING
FLUORESCENCE IMAGING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred fifty-six
thousand dollars (\$356,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to Brody
School of Medicine at East Carolina University to fund personnel, equipment, and
operating expenses for the early detection of lung cancer using fluorescence imaging.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
