A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM AT THE  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of four hundred forty-eight  
thousand three hundred forty-nine dollars (\$448,349) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.  
These funds shall be allocated to the TEACCH Program in the Department of  
Psychiatry at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, as follows:

- (1) \$283,349 to increase the psychoeducatioal therapists' salaries and for additional fringe benefits.
- (2) \$145,000 for TEACCH clinic rents and operations.
- (3) \$20,000 for the TEACCH DX and Medical Consultation Clinic.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
