SENATE BILL 300*

Short Title: Clarify Veterinary Urine Test Requirements. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT A VETERINARIAN WHO OPERATES A MOBILE FACILITY MAY ENTER INTO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT TO HAVE URINE TESTS PERFORMED BY ANOTHER FACILITY OR LABORATORY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 11 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 90-187.16. Mobile facility laboratory services.

Notwithstanding G.S. 90-185, G.S. 90-186, or rules adopted pursuant to them, a veterinarian who operates a mobile facility may enter into a written agreement to have urine tests performed by another veterinary practice facility, a public laboratory, or a private laboratory capable of performing this laboratory service."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
