17 18 **SECTION 6.** All existing ordinances and resolutions of the Town of Mt. Pleasant and all existing rules or regulations of departments or agencies of the Town of Mt. Pleasant not inconsistent with the provisions of this act shall continue in full force and effect until repealed, modified, or amended.

SECTION 7. No action or proceeding of any nature (whether civil or criminal, judicial or administrative, or otherwise) pending at the effective date of this act by or against the Town of Mt. Pleasant or any of its departments or agencies shall be abated or otherwise affected by the adoption of this act.

SECTION 8. If any part of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 9. Whenever a reference is made in this act to a particular provision of the General Statutes, and such provision is later amended, repealed, or superceded, the reference shall be deemed amended to refer to the amended General Statute or to the General Statute which most nearly corresponds to the statutory provision which is repealed or superceded.

SECTION 10. This act is effective when it becomes law.
