2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR NEW POSITIONS NEEDED TO ASSIST
3 THE NORTH CAROLINA INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION TO ENSURE THAT
4 THE COMMISSION HAS ADEQUATE RESOURCES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North
7 Carolina Industrial Commission the sum of one hundred fifty-two thousand one hundred
8 ninety-four dollars (\$152,194) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to establish and support
9 two Administrative Officer II (workers' compensation fraud investigator) positions and
10 two Program Assistant V positions and the sum of one hundred fifty-two thousand one
11 hundred ninety-four dollars (\$152,194) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to continue and
12 support these positions.

13 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North
14 Carolina Industrial Commission the sum of one hundred sixty-one thousand six hundred
15 seventy-two dollars (\$161,672) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to establish and support
16 two Administrative Officer II (ombudsman) positions, one Program Assistant V
17 position, and one Receptionist III position and the sum of one hundred sixty-one
18 thousand six hundred seventy-two dollars (\$161,672) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to
19 continue and support these positions.

20 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North
21 Carolina Industrial Commission the sum of two hundred thousand seven hundred
22 ninety-five dollars (\$200,795) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to establish and support
23 four Industrial Safety Rep II positions and one Program Assistant V position and the
24 sum of two hundred thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$200,795) for the
25 2006-2007 fiscal year to continue and support these positions.

26 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
