A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE PAY OF TEACHER ASSISTANTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one million one hundred fifty thousand two hundred forty dollars (\$1,150,240) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million one hundred fifty thousand two hundred forty dollars (\$1,150,240) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to provide sufficient funds to pay State-funded teacher assistants at least the minimum of salary grade 56.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
